Models: Some 2023 Model Year Telluride Trims

Take the time to explain the operation of the **Digital Center Mirror*** to applicable Telluride customers during the vehicle orientation process.

The Digital Center Mirror is designed to use the rear view camera equipped on the vehicle to display an image of the area behind the vehicle on the Digital Center Mirror screen/rear view mirror. The Digital Center Mirror can help the driver to see a view of the rear despite the potential presence of obstructions within the vehicle, helping to enhance rear visibility.

Operation:



- Pull the mode select lever (A) to turn 'ON' Digital Mirror Mode.
- Push the mode select lever (A) to turn 'OFF' Digital Mirror Mode and display Optical Mirror Mode.

Digital Mirror Mode Display Settings:

The brightness and camera view can be adjusted 'up/down' in the display settings.

- Press the 'Menu' (B) button to select 'brightness' or 'up/down' adjustment.
- Press the 'Select' (C) button to adjust the brightness or camera view.
